- ADAM GRANT** – Rose Pink with bright Yellow anthers. Very large peony form. Average, upright growth. M - L. (U. S. 2010 – Marion Grant Hall, Dothan, AL).
- AL EWAN** – Bright Red with Yellow anthers and Yellow filaments. Large to very large semidouble. Average, upright growth. M. (U. S. 2009 – Albert Ewan, Charleston, SC).
- ALLIE** – Rose Pink with White overtones with Golden Yellow anthers and White filaments. Medium to Large semidouble to full peony. Vigorous, upright, open growth. E - M. (U. S. 2011 – Bill Howell, Wilmington, NC).
- ANACOSTIA** – Medium Pink (RHS 55A) with Yellow anthers and Ivory filaments. Medium semidouble. Average, upright growth. E - M.. (U. S. 2010 – Sylvester (Skip) March, Washington, DC).
- AOI-SANGOSHÔ (BLUE CORAL REEF)** – Deep bluish purple with White filaments and Yellow anthers. Miniature single bloom. M. (Japan 1988 – Shigeyuki Iwatsubo, Tanegashima Island, Kagoshima Prefecture, Kyûshû).
- APRIL KISS** - *Pinkish Red. Small to medium formal double. Slow to average, upright growth with heavy bud set. Cold hardy - Zone 6B. M. (C. japonica 'Berenice Boddy' x C. japonica 'Reg Ragland')* (U. S. 1995 - Clifford R. Parks).
- ASHTON'S RED SUNSET** – Red-Purple (RHS 58C) with Yellow anthers and creamy White filaments. Medium semidouble. Average, spreading, low, dense growth. E - M. (*C. japonica 'Frost Queen'* x *C. japonica 'Variety Z'*) (U. S. 2010 – Dr. William L. Ackerman, Ashton, MD).
- BAISAN XUESHI (WHITE THREE SCHOLARS)** - White with a rare Pink or Red mark. Medium, rose form double to formal double. Average, upright, very dense growth. M. - L. (China 1981 - Wang & Yü).
- BEBE'S BEST** – Light Pink with rose striping and bright Yellow anthers. Very large loose peony form with crepe like petals in center of flower. Average, upright growth. E - L. Sport of *C. japonica 'Adam Grant'*. (U. S. 2012 – Marion Hall, Dothan, AL).
- BELINDA GAIL** – Red with dark veining. Medium semidouble. Average, upright growth. M - L. (U. S. 2010 – Melvin Stallings, Chesapeake, VA).
- BETTE ANNE** – Light Lavender Pink. Medium rose form double. Average, upright, dense growth. E - L. (U. S. 2009 – Richard Hooten, Pensacola, FL).
- BEV PIET'S SMILE** – Dark Red and White with Yellow anthers and light Pink/White filaments. Large semidouble to peony form. Average, upright growth. M (U. S. 2008 – Meyer Piet, Arcadia, CA)
- BEV RITTER** – Sport of 'Show Time'. Clear light Pink. Medium formal double. Vigorous, upright growth. M. (U. S. 2010 – Charles D. Ritter, Melrose, FL).
- BRIAN'S DREAM** – Light Red with darker Red stripes with Yellow anthers and white filaments. Medium semidouble to anemone form. Average, upright growth. E. (U. S. 2012 – Brian S. Dick, Lakeland, FL).
- CABERNET** – Rich Burgundy Red. Small formal double. Average, bushy, Average, bushy, upright growth. L. (U. S. 2009 – Nuccio's Nurseries, Altadena, CA).
- CAMILLE** – Pink Rose. Large formal double with heavy petal texture. Upright with vigorous growth. M. (U. S. 2006 – E. Hulyn Smith, Valdosta, GA).
- CARL ALLEN, JR.** – Rose Red, blotched White. Medium, anemone to peony form. Average, spreading growth. E - M. (U. S. 1999 – Henry B. Rehder, Wilmington, NC).
- CARROLL WALLER** – Pale Pink. Large, peony form. Average, growth. E - M. (U. S. 1999 – L. B. Wilson, Jr. and H. Schall, Jr., Gulfport, MS).
- CARO-LAN** – Dark Pink with lighter Pink in center. Medium, formal double. Incurved petals, star-shaped and stacked with heavy texture. Open, average, growth rate. M - L. (U. S. 2006 – Harold Haeffle, Hampstead, NC).
- CHARLES TURNER** - Dark Red. *Large*, semidouble. Vigorous, upright growth. M - L. (U.S. 1954 - Turner)
- CHARLIE V** – Red and White with Yellow anthers. Medium loose peony form. Vigorous, upright growth. M. (U. S. 2009 – Hal Vanis, Henderson, TX).
- CHIEF ARNOLD** – Very dark Red with Yellow anthers and Red and Yellow filaments. Large to very large semidouble. Vigorous, upright growth. M. (U. S. 2009 – E. Hulyn Smith, Valdosta, GA).
- CHIKUSHI-NO-HARU (SPRING IN CHIKUSHI)** – Pale Pink with fine peppering of Pink dots, large and round. Large semidouble to peony form. E - M. (Japan 1970 – Murata Teruo, Fukuoka Prefecture).
- CHRISTINE COLLINS** – Blush Pink with Yellow anthers and White filaments. Medium to large semidouble to loose peony form. Slow, upright growth. L. (U. S. 2011 – James P. Taylor - deceased, Quitman, GA).

- CILE WATFORD** – White. Medium rose form double. Vigorous, upright, dense growth. M. (U. S. 2009 – Walton Homeyer, Macon, GA).
- DADDY MAC** – White with flecks and streaks of dark Red, deep Coral Pink and light to medium Pink. Large, peony to anemone form. Slow, spreading, open growth. E – M. (U. S. 2009 – John M Davy, Milton, FL).
- DAD’S PINK** – Candy-striped, half Pink or solid Pink. Medium, formal double. Vigorous, compact growth. Color sport of *C. japonica* ‘Romany’ M. (U. S. 2011 – Ray Watson, Sanford, NC).
- DAISY EAGLESON** – Light Pink and white having 50 petals. Miniature rose form double. Rapid, upright and dense growth. E - M. (Grafted *C. japonica* seedling onto Maiden’s Blush *sasanqua* under stock) (U. S. 1961 – Tom Eagleson, Port Arthur, TX).
- DARK OF NIGHT** – Dark Red with Yellow Anthers and Pink filaments. Medium semidouble. Average, upright growth. M – L. (*C. japonica* 'Tinsie' x *C. japonica* 'Fuyajo') (U. S. 2009 – Jim Moon, Portland , OR).
- DEEP PURPLE DREAM** – Deep Purple Red with Yellow filaments and stamens. Medium semidouble to rose form double to peony. Vigorous, upright, dense growth. E-M. (U. S. 2009 – John L. Spencer, Lakeland, FL).
- DOROTHY B. DECUERS** – Rose Pink with Yellow to Orange anthers and Ivory filaments. Medium semidouble to rose form double. Average upright growth. (U. S. 2008 – Shirah’s Camellia Nursery, Lakeland, FL)
- DOROTHY L . CHATTIN** – Pink. Medium formal double. Slow, spreading growth. (U. S. 2008 – Shirah’s Camellia Nursery, Lakeland, FL)
- DRAMA GIRL TISON** – Pink petals with a white margin. Very large semidouble. Vigorous, upright, open growth. E – M. (U. S. 2008 – Dr. Frank A Wilson III, Leslie, GA).
- EDWIN S. NORTHUP** – Cream White. Large peony form with notched petals. Vigorous, spreading growth. M. (U. S. 1950 – Wilkinson).
- ELAINE'S BETTY PINK** - Sport of 'Elaine's Betty'. Medium Pink center shading to deeper Pink at petal edges. Medium, peony form to rose form double with highly ruffled petals. Vigorous, open, upright growth. Foliage is creped and serrated. M. (U. S. 2010 – James and Elaine Smelley, Moss Point, MS)
- ELAINE'S BETTY RED** - Sport of 'Elaine's Betty'. Deep Rose to Red center shading to deeper Red at petal edges. Medium, peony form to rose form double with highly ruffled petals. Vigorous, open, upright growth. Foliage is creped and serrated. M. (U. S. 2010 – James and Elaine Smelley, Moss Point, MS)
- ELIZABETH NEDRA MATHIS** – Dark Red with yellow anthers and Red filaments. Large, semidouble. Vigorous, upright, dense growth. M. (U. S. 2009 – Clayton Mathis, Douglas, GA).
- EMBERGLOW** – Bluish Rose fading to Magenta. Small to medium, semidouble to formal double. Slow, upright growth. M - L. (*C. japonica* 'Edna Campbell Variegated' x unknown pollen parent). (U. S. 2012 – C. M. & Lillian Gordy, Ocala, FL).
- EVA ROSS** – Ivory White streaked and splotched Cherry Red with Yellow anthers and Cream filaments. Medium, semidouble. Vigorous, spreading growth. M. (U. S. 1999 – Frank Galloway, Bolivia, NC).
- FENSAN XUESHI (PINK THREE SCHOLARS)** - Pink with occasional Red tick. Medium formal double, star shaped with incurved petal edges. Average, upright, very dense growth. M. - L. Sport of *C. japonica* 'Baisan Xueshi'. (China 1981 - Wang & Yü).
- FRANCES COUNCIL** – White, miniature formal double. Average, upright growth. E - M. (U. S. 1971 – Tammia).
- GENA OWENS FREDRICKSON** – Light Pink in center to dark Pink at edges with Yellow anthers and White filaments. Medium semidouble to loose peony form. Average, upright growth. M. (U. S. 2012 – Edward W. Fredrickson, Wilmington, NC)
- GEORGIA FIRE** – Dark Red with Yellow anthers and Yellow filaments. Medium rose form double. Vigorous, upright growth. M – L. (U. S. 2009 – E. Hulyn Smith, Valdosta, GA).
- GEORGIA NATIONAL FAIR BLUSH** – Blush Pink with a large amount of White with Yellow anthers and Yellow filaments. Large to very large peony form. Vigorous, upright, dense growth. E – L. (U. S. 2009 – E. Hulyn Smith, Valdosta, GA).
- HARBOR LIGHTS** - Red with white frosting on petaloids. Medium to large anemone form. Average, upright growth. Very cold hardy. E - . (U. S. 1980's - Mark Cannon, Dothan, AL).
- HENNY DREWS** – Pale Pink and White. Medium peony form. Upright with average growth. E – M. (U. S. 2006 – Robert E. Drews, Charleston, SC).
- HONGLUZHEN. (RED SHOWING TREASURE)** – Deep Scarlet. Large semidouble to loose peony form. Vigorous, upright growth. Sport of Hualuzhen. M – L. (China. 1993 – Jiyin Gao, Fujian Province).
- ITCH** – White with Yellow anthers and White filaments. Large single to semidouble form. Average, upright growth. E – M. (U. S. 2009 – William Brierly, Mobile, AL).

- JIM MCCORMACK** – Pink at margins, fading to pale pink in the center with Yellow anthers and creamy White filaments. Medium semidouble form. Vigorous, upright, dense growth. E – M. (U. S. 2009 – Dr. William L. Ackerman, Ashton, MD).
- JOHANNA TAYLOR** – White with an occasional Pink stripe or two with Yellow anthers and Yellow filaments. Medium semidouble form. Average, upright growth. M. (U. S. 2010 – Donald Taylor, New Bern, NC).
- JOHN SHIRAH JR.** – White with light Pink flecks with Yellow anthers and Ivory filaments. Very large semidouble. Vigorous, upright growth. E – M. Vigorous, upright growth. E. – M. (U. S. 2008 – John W. Shirah, Lakeland, FL).
- JONEL** – Rose Pink. Small to medium formal double. Average, upright growth. M. (U. S. 2009 – Mark Crawford, Valdosta, GA).
- KATIE NORTHCUTT VARIEGATED** – Light Pink variegated White with Yellow anthers and Yellow filaments. Very large, semidouble to peony form. Vigorous, upright growth. E - M. (U. S. 2010 – Ed Northcutt, Valdosta, GA).
- KIRSTI LEIGH** – White. Large, consistent loose peony form. Average, spreading, upright growth. E - M. (U. S. 2005 – Sally H. and Stephen A. Erickson, Kiln, MS).
- KOREAN FIRE** – Red. Small to medium, single form. Compact with handsome foliage. E. (Korea. 1984 ? – Barry Yinger, Lewisberry, PA).
- KOSHI-NO-YOSO'OL. (NIIGATA ADORNMENT)** – Blush Orchid Pink. Medium, formal double with small, rounded, shallow notched petals arranged in tiered or star shape. Upright, sturdy growth. E - M. (Japan. 1970 – Mitsuroku Makino, Fuchû Town, Niigata Prefecture).
- KUTE KATE** – Bright Red. Small formal double to peony form. Average, upright, open growth. E–M. (U. S. 2009 – John L. Spencer, Lakeland, FL).
- LAURA'S BEAUTY** – Red and White Striped. Medium semidouble to peony form. Average, upright, open growth. E–L. (U. S. 2011 – N. C. Barnard, St. Elmo, AL).
- LAUREN TUDOR PINK** – Solid Pink with Gold anthers and filaments. Very large peony form. A sport of Lauren Tudor. Vigorous, upright growth. E–M. (U. S. 2004 – E. Hulyn Smith, Valdosta, GA).
- LEMON GLOW** – Yellow. Medium formal double sport of 'Dahlohnega'. Vigorous, compact growth. M. (U. S. 2009 – Cam Too Camellia Nursery, Greensboro, NC).
- LEONA RISH** – Pale Pink. *Medium*, peony form. Average, upright growth. E - M. (U. S. 1998 – W. Rish, Winnsboro, SC).
- LORI CLEVINGER** – Dark Pink with streaks and flecks of dark Coral Pink. Small to medium peony form. Average upright, spreading and open growth. E – M. (U. S. 2009 – John M Davy, Milton, FL).
- LUCY O** – White with Yellow anthers and light Yellow filaments. Large semidouble. Average, upright growth. E – M. (U. S. 2011 – Lindsey Odom, Wilmington, NC).
- LUNDY'S LEGACY** – Coral Red with blush Pink fringe with Golden anthers and Cream filaments. Medium to large peony form. Average, upright growth. M – L. (U. S. 2009 – T. E. Lundy, Pensacola, FL).
- M. L. SPENCER** – Light Pink with Lavender shading. Small to medium formal double. Average, upright growth. E. (U. S. 2005 – John L. Spencer, Lakeland, FL).
- MARIE CRAWFORD** – Soft Pink with gold anthers and cream filaments. Medium semidouble to loose peony form, Average, spreading growth. E - M. (U. S. 2010 – Clarence & Lillian Gordy, Ocala, FL).
- MELANIE ANNE POE** – White to light Pink with one to two Red petals and with medium Yellow anthers and Cream filaments. Very large anemone form. Average, spreading growth. M – L. (U. S. 2009 – W. Lee Poe, Jr., Aiken, SC).
- MELISSA BEALE TALLEY** – Medium Pink with Yellow anthers and White filaments. Large semidouble. Average, upright, open growth. M. (U. S. 2010 – John Talley, Wilmington, NC).
- MIYAKODORI-NAGOYA (NAGOYA GULL)** – White with a shade of yellow at base. Formal double. L. (Japan. 1968 – Aichi Prefecture).
- MISTER TIM** – Dark Red with yellow anthers and White filaments. Medium semidouble. Average, upright growth. L. (U. S. 2009 – Webb Hart, Carriere, MS).
- MOMOJI-NO-HIGURASHI (AN EVENING IN MOMOJI)** – Deep Pink petals with Crimson and white streakings with yellow anthers and Creamy filaments. Medium semidouble. Medium, upright growth. E - L. (Japan. 1971 – Minoru Satô, Aichi Prefecture).
- ORANDAKÔ** - Deep Pink striped White. Small, formal double. Vigorous, upright growth. E. - L. (Japan 1733 - Chikinchô Furoku).
- OYLER'S CAROLYNMARIE VARIEGATED** – Red with White Splotches with Golden anthers. Medium semidouble. Slow, upright open growth. M. (U. S. 2010– Donald R. Oyler, Mobile, AL).

- OYLER'S CHRISTINA MARIE** – White. Medium formal double. Average, upright growth. M. (U. S. 2010 – Donald R. Oyler, Mobile, AL).
- OYLER'S RACHEL MARIE** – Light Pink with deeper Pink on the underside of the petals with Golden anthers. Medium semidouble. Average, upright growth. E. - M. (U. S. 2010 – Donald R. Oyler, Mobile, AL).
- Q BALL** – Deep Rose with Yellow anthers. Very large peony form. Vigorous, upright, dense growth. E. - L. (U. S. 2010 – Eleanor Grant, Dothan, AL).
- PARKER CONNOR** – Shaded from very palest blush pink at center to pale pink at outer edge of inner petals. Outer petals shade from pale pink center to deep pink on tips. Medium, semidouble. Vigorous, upright growth. M. (U. S. 2012 – Parker Connor, Edisto Island, SC).
- PEGGY'S BLUSH** – White with Peach Blush. *Small to medium* formal double. Vigorous, dense, upright growth. M - L. (U. S. 1991 – D. Applegate, Pensacola, FL).
- PHILLIP TAYLOR** – Vivid Red with Yellow anthers and White filaments. Medium to large, semidouble to loose peony form. Average, upright growth. M - L. (sport of *C. japonica* 'Phillip Taylor Peppermint') (U. S. 2011 – Christine T. Collins, Quitman, GA).
- PHILLIP TAYLOR PEPPERMINT** – Blush Pink with vivid Red stripes with Yellow anthers and White filaments. Medium to large, semidouble to loose peony form. Average, upright growth. M - L. (*C. japonica* 'Horkan' x unknown pollen parent) (U. S. 2011 – Christine T. Collins, Quitman, GA).
- PINK-A-BOO** – White, turning to blush Pink and finally blush Yellow with Yellow filaments and stamens. Medium anemone form. Average, spreading growth. E - M. (U. S. 2009 – John L. Spencer, Lakeland, FL).
- POP'S PERFECTION** – Medium Pink flecked and streaked with darker Burgundy to deep Coral Pink at the center of petals. Medium formal double form. Slow, spreading, open growth. M - L. (U. S. 2009 – John M Davy, Milton, FL).
- PRINCESS MASAKO** – White with a Red border and small and large stripes. Medium to large lotus-form semidouble to peony form. A mutation of Ikari-shibori. Vigorous, initially upright and later spreading growth. M - L. (Japan. 1989 – Sôshin Hirai, Saitama Prefecture)
- RED DEVIL** – Red. Small to medium semidouble. Average, upright somewhat columnar growth. M - L. (U. S. 2009 – Nuccio's Nurseries, Altadena, CA).
- RHODA GONZALEZ** – White. Medium, full peony form. Vigorous, open growth. E. (U. S. 1952 – Mrs. C. F. Gonzalez, Pensacola, FL).
- RUTH C. MCNAIR** – White having 3 to 4 rows of large, broad, layered outer petals which are slightly down-curved. Inner petals are upward and fluted and sometimes crinkled and irregular, mixed with many petaloids and bright Yellow stamens with White filaments in the middle. Large peony form. Average, spreading, dense growth. M - L. (U. S. 2009 – John M Davy, Milton, FL).
- RUTH TINKLE** – Red with faint White streaks on innermost petals and White anthers.. Medium semidouble to rose form double. Average, upright growth. M - L. (U. S. 2010 – Oscar Tinkle, Portland, OR).
- SANDRA WILLIAMS** – Dark Pink to medium Red with variegation. *Small*, peony form. Vigorous, dense and upright growth. E - M. (U. S. 2005 – Jay Ellis, Keystone Hts., FL).
- SAWADA'S MAHOGANY** – Dark Red with red and white petaloids. *Medium to large peony form*. Upright with vigorous growth. E - L. (U. S. 1971 – K. Sawada, Mobile, AL, Propagated by Bobby Green, Fairhope, AL).
- SHOKKÔ-NISHIKI (LIGHT OF SECHUAN BROCADE)** - *Dark Pink virus variegated White with Higo-like large Yellow stamens*. Large, *single*. *Very slow upright growth habit*. M. - L. (*Japan 1841 - Yashiro, Kansai Area*).
- SOUTHEASTERN FLOWER SHOW** – Medium Pink (RHS 54A Red group). Very large, semidouble to anemone form. Average, upright, open growth. E. - L. (U. S. 2011 – Richard "Dick" Dodd, Marshallville, GA).
- SPORTING CLASS** – White with flecks, streaks and petals of dark Coral Pink, medium Pink and light Pink. Medium, peony form. Average, upright, spreading, dense growth. E. (U. S. 2009 – John M. Davy, Milton, FL).
- STEPHENS GARDEN** – Pink shading to darker Pink. Small, formal double. Upright, vigorous growth rate. M. - L. (U. S. 2008 – Bobby Green, Fairhope, FL).
- TOM HATLEY** – Vivid deep Red with Yellow anthers and White to Pink filaments. Medium to large, semidouble. Upright, open average growth rate. M. (U. S. 2011 – M. Thomas Hatley, Charlotte, NC).
- TOICHI DOMOTO** – Rose Pink with deep Rose Pink stripes. Medium formal double to rose form double. Upright, compact slow growth. E. - M. (U. S. 2006 – Nuccio's).
- TRUDY GEORGE** – Pink with stripes as in 'Ben George' with higo type stamen clusters. It has Yellow anthers and lighter colored filaments. Very large, single to semidouble. Vigorous, upright growth. M. (U. S. 2008 – E. Hulyn Smith, Valdosta, GA).

**VARIETY Z** – Dark Pink (RHS Red Purple group 62A). The petaloids are light Pink (RHS Red Purple group 62C). It has creamy White anthers and White filaments. Medium rose form double to formal double. Average, upright growth. M. (U. S. 2009 – Dr. William L. Ackerman, Ashton, MD).

**VICTORIA VANIS** – Light blush Pink. Medium formal double. Vigorous, upright growth. M. (U. S. 2009 – Hal Vanis, Henderson, TX).

**VIRGINIA SUNRISE** - Red blotched white with yellow anthers and pink filaments. Medium to large semidouble to anemone form. Vigorous, upright growth. M. (U. S. 2012 - Dr. J. M. Habel, Jr., Suffolk, VA)

**WALKER LEWIS** – Dark Pink with White picotee edges with White anthers and White filaments. Medium semidouble to peony form. Vigorous, upright growth. E - M. (U. S. 2010 – Pat Johnson, Cairo, GA).

**WHOOPEE RED** – Purplish Red sport of ‘Whoopee’. (U. S. 2011 – Charles Ritter, Melrose, FL).

**YEAMANS HALL** – Shell Pink with darker Pink striping. Medium formal double. *Average, upright, dense growth*. E - L. (U. S. 2006 – Sam Boren, Propagated by Coastal Carolina Camellia Society, Mt. Pleasant, SC).

*reticulata* hyb. 'Buddha' x *C. fraterna* hyb. 'Tiny  
Princess')]. M. (U. S. 1988 – Dan Charvet, Fort

**BARBARA GOFF** – Soft Pink with yellow anthers and  
yellow filaments. Very large semidouble to rose form  
double to formal double. Average, upright growth. E  
- M/E - L (U. S. 2009 – Gordon Goff, Lafayette,  
CA).

**BEAUTIFUL DAY** - White with Blush on outer petals.  
Medium, irregular formal double. Strong, upright,  
open growth. {(*C. pitardii* var. 'Yunnanica' x *C.*  
*reticulata* hyb. 'Forty-Niner') x [*C. reticulata* 'Crimson  
Robe' x (*C. reticulata* 'Crimson Robe' x *C. fraterna*)]}  
M. (U. S. 2007 – Dan Charvet, Fort Bragg, CA).

**BETTE JEAN DAUGHARTY** – Light or clear Pink with  
golden Yellow anthers and Yellow filaments. Very  
large semidouble. Vigorous, upright growth. M – L.  
(*C. reticulata* 'Suzanne Withers' x *C. reticulata* 'Nita  
McRae') (U. S. 2009 – E. Hulyn Smith, Valdosta,  
GA).

**BLOOMFIELD** - Velvety Red. Large to very large, rose
